

Mangrove Trails Paddle June 2105 – Chronicled by Jon Markey It has been said, it is not about the destination but rather about the journey.

Never were truer words spoken!

The gathering of the clan of GlenLakes Kayakers started at around 9:30 am on a bright, sunny morning at Fred Howard Park in Tarpon Springs (which by the way requires you to leave a trail of bread crumbs as you seek to find it). It was certainly not our largest group but then again not our smallest. We band of fifteen got reacquainted as we unloaded the gear and waited for our Aardvark partner to unload the rental yaks. The prospects seemed very favorable.

The trail was untested (recently) by our group and offered a different type of paddle, through mangroves to our ultimate destination, Lake Avoca.

As we got organized the challenges arose. Our planned PC (paddle coordinator for the uninitiated) Ken Rupin was on the DL with a bad back. Yours truly became the PC and the only safety for the day, meaning we had the lead covered by Matt from Aardvark, me at the rear with the merry group in the middle.

Next up, where was the water? No sign of the Gulf. Aha, that narrow sliver of dark water leading into the tunnel of the mangroves was our way out. Good luck. Single file with paddles split into two pieces and paddling with one we sallied forth. For those that haven't ventured into the confines of a mangrove trail it is a test of precision paddling combined with the limbo to go under the overhanging branches. For most that meant slow forward progress with occasional backing up to move through a tighter spots while being on the alert for possible critters in the branches. But, good news, no critters encountered. But also no sunlight since little was penetrating to the water. After many lefts and rights deftly stroked by the group we broke into open water and reassembled in the bright light of mid-morning. All

present and accounted for we set off in search of the mangrove trail that would lead us to Lake Avoca.

After a brief ten-minute paddle across the clear water of the gulf with no wind nor waves to inhibit our progress the group made a sharp right-hand turn down a somewhat wider inlet into the mangroves. This one wide enough to permit the paddles to stay assembled. Twenty minutes later and with the group still intact, forward stroking ceased! Our guide determined that this wasn't the way into the lake.

We dutifully turned around and paddled back the way we came. We headed north for five more minutes.

This is the way in (didn't really look too promising since the entire left side of the channel was lined by very large houses).

Twenty minutes down the channel, nope, no lake. Let's turn around again and search for the lost entrance! Aha, this is it.

Looks good, somewhat narrow, but what the heck no one said we would be paddling on a highway. Fifteen minutes in we make a sharp left into an even narrower, single-file route. The cry comes back, kayak over! Someone had ignored the Curt's second rule of kayaking, "don't grab the tree branches", they did and they went over. I paddle quickly ahead as Matt retraces his path to find a paddler standing waist deep in water and mid-calf deep in mud with an overturned, sit-in kayak filled with water. Too narrow to do a proper recovery (as we learned in our safety training), I jump into the water and immediately sink to mid-calf as well. Matt and I wrestle the kayak and empty it of water, get it repositioned and provide the necessary manpower to get our paddler back into his kayak.

Five minutes later we break into the clear, but it is the same channel with the same houses we just left! Back to the Gulf.

A few more strokes of the paddles and off again into another trail. Oops, deadend. Back to the Gulf.

Rest, get out and wade. Looks like a very

large storm cell off to the south. Rumble, flash, yep a standard early summer storm is brewing.

Decision made, time to get off the water, but that means yet another mangrove trail, different than before, more turns and longer. All the while the storm closes in. Finally the kayaks are pulled except for the safety bringing up the rear and the group is off to lunch at *Hellas* in Tarpon Springs. The storm broke as I pulled my kayak but I was determined to get it onto the roof of the Mini so we could join the party. Getting thoroughly soaked required a quick change in the park facilities. Hellas was a treat. Excellent Greek menu (unaffected by the looming default of the parent country) and a delightful bakery loaded with outstanding low-calorie delights that became the takeout for the ride home. Thus a fine journey with good friends but no Lake Avoca!



Section 9: Vehicles and Parking

. . .

- C. **Inoperative vehicles** shall not be permitted on the Premises except within enclosed garages. For purposes of this Rule, a vehicle shall be considered "inoperative" if (a) it has not been driven under its own propulsion for a period of two weeks, or longer, (b) it does not have an operable propulsion system installed therein, (c) it is obviously inoperative for a period of twenty four (24) hours, (d) it does not have legally attached number plates issued by the State of Florida (or similar numbered plate from another state or country) with a validating tab or sticker for the current year, or (e) it is put up on blocks, or (f) it is covered with a tarpaulin.
- D. No rRepair work may be performed on vehicles only while the vehicles are inside the garage.in drive ways.

. . .

- I. No vehicle shall be covered when parked in a driveway. Covered vehicles shall not be parked anywhere except within an enclosed garage.
- J. **Overnight parking is not permitted** in any common area of GlenLakes, including, but not limited to, the clubhouse, presentation center, or mail kiosk area.

Here are some interesting statistics from the French Open. This was printed recently in one of my Professional Magazines.

- 4,467 racquets total, up 304 from last year
- 706 players strung for
- 33 miles of string used
- Lowest tension: Mikhail Kukushkin-21 lbs
- Highest tension: Dustin Brown-70.5 lbs
- Most racquets strung: Serena with 70
- 32% of the racquets strung were Babolat, 30% Wilson and 17% Head
- Most used racquet is the Pure Drive at 13%, followed by the Blade at 11.5% and the Aeropro Drive at 10.5%

Trivia question...

How many COWS does it take to string a tennis racquet? I will answer that question as soon as I inform many that they DO NOT USE CAT to make gut strings. It is the intestine (gut) of cows that is used.

Gut is the ONLY string that gives you the very best feel and touch. It also should be used if a player suffers from severe tennis elbow. PLUS it should be strung at LOWER tension to offset SHOCK from impact giving the elbow relief. 30 or more years ago it smelled of formaldehyde and was very susceptible to moisture and rain. Now it has no odor and is protected to inhibit moisture from affecting its durability. You should still however protect it from the rain. It very expensive compared to most synthetic string. It can break over night. It can last as long as regular synthetic string. It is GUT...and that's just how it goes. But for the ultimate playing experience...go with GUT. Or at least a hybrid job using half gut and

half synthetic string... costs \$55.00. Now to answer the question from above:

For those of you that are very literal....*NO*. Cows can not string tennis racquets. The real answer. It takes about three cows to make one set of natural gut tennis string. Mooooo



The Rules Of Play - By Judy Voiers, *Rules Chairman* Rule 13-4. Ball in Hazard; Prohibited Actions


Q. A player's ball lies in a bunker and a rake has been left in another part of the bunker. Prior to making her stroke in the bunker, the player retrieves the rake. Having lifted the rake, the player smoothes the footprints that she has just created, and some others in the process of getting back to her ball. What is the ruling?

A. There is no penalty provided the smoothing was done for the sole purpose of caring for the course and nothing was done to breach Rule 13-2 (Improving the Lie, Area of Intended Stance or Swing, or Line of Play) in relation to the player's next stroke (See Exception 2 to Rule 13-4, page 66).

Rule 13-4 can be found on page 65 of your USGA's Rules of Golf and the Rules of Amateur Status 2012-2015. If you do not already have one, copies are available in the Pro Shop.





Managing Chronic Back Pain

Back pain is one of the most common reasons patients visit doctors. Many people have been suffering from chronic back pain for years and tried numerous treatment options to try to control their pain. Unfortunately not many physicians know how to treat chronic back pain and usually tell the patient that they must learn to live with their pain. This is rather sad since we have numerous options available to help patients manage their pain.


As a pain management specialist, I have seen thousands of patients suffering from chronic back pain and have been able to help the majority of these patients. When I see a patient with chronic back pain, I begin with a thorough evaluation to find out the cause of the pain. After the evaluation I usually order or obtain copies of radiology studies to help me understand the actual cause of the pain. Once we know the cause, we can begin to work together to control the pain.

The evaluation and studies usually are able to discover the cause. There are numerous causes, too many to mention here, but the most common are disc diseases, arthritis of the spine, narrowing of the spinal canal or previous surgery on the back.

The first line of treatment might include the conservative approach with physical therapy, anti-inflammatory medications and if indicated, muscle relaxants and some newly developed antidepressants that are FDA approved for back pain. If this fails, or has already been tried in the past, the next line of treatment could include simple injection techniques performed in the office. These include epidural steroid injections, medial branch nerve blocks, or sacroiliac joint injections. The epidural steroid injection is a procedure where x-ray guidance is used to place long-lasting steroids near the cause of the problem that was identified by previous studies.

This can be repeated if successful and can last

many months to alleviate the pain. The medial branch nerve blocks are also x-ray guided injections to help alleviate the pain from arthritis of the back and are also very helpful especially if

bending or extending the back is painful. The sacroiliac joint injections are performed with x-ray guidance to place long-lasting steroid into the joint.

If these treatment options are ineffective, I have extremely good success with spinal cord stimulators that are excellent at controlling pain without the need for numerous injections and medications. The product by Boston Scientific in my experience provides the best relief for low back pain. I first do a trial in the office where I place the electrodes under x-ray guidance, and the patient tries the simulation for 3 – 5 days. If the patient likes the relief of the pain, then I arrange for the patient to have a permanent stimulator. You can find out more about this at www.controlyourpain.com.

The spinal cord stimulator is also an excellent choice for patients suffering from back pain after back surgery, diabetic neuropathy or sciatica. Medicare and insurance carriers cover all the options I have mentioned.

So as you can see, there are many treatment options available for chronic back pain as well as many other pain ailments such as neuropathy, sciatica, post herpetic neuralgia and chronic neck pain.
