How to Use This Book

The book is organized as listed in the <u>Table of Contents</u>. The Sections listed in the Table of Contents are linked to the sections indicated. Simply "click" on the page number and you will be taken to the page you want.

Blue text items are links to other sections (<u>Villas</u>, <u>Single Homes</u>, and <u>Country Club and Manor Homes</u>) of the book or will return you to the <u>Table of Contents</u>, as indicated.

The models are organized by types of homes in alphabetical order.

Introduction

The floor plans and models included in this book are derived from sales brochures used by the realtors. There are over 70 models of homes built in Timber Pines from 1982-1997. Many of the models resulted from simple name changes of previous models with slight changes to the plan. Models range from one bedroom, one bath villas with a carport to single homes with three car garages, three bathrooms and three bedrooms or more.

There were various model home locations. Before the Grand Opening of Timber Pines, homes were selected from models located at Timber Oaks. In 1983, one of the first TPCA model centers, was located on Timber Lodge Lane, Tract 17, Greenbriar. In 1990, a second model center was built behind the tennis courts at the Lodge where model homes were located along Countryside Ridge Lane and along Rolling Green Drive. This is Tract 20, Rolling Green Village. Another location is Mulligan Court along hole number 10 of the Lakes, Tract 19, Woodlake Village in 1990.

In 1991, US Home declared Chapter 11 bankruptcy and other builders were allowed to build homes in Timber Pines. They were Alexander, Artistic, and Royal Coachman. Their model homes include the first three homes on the right side of Crystal Lake Drive in Country Club Village, Tract 26, across from the country club. Regency built villas in such as the Fairway Series in Evergreen Village.

The last model center location was on Fairskies Drive, Tract 42 Country Greens Village in 1994.

Decorated models could also be found at other locations around Timber Pines.

Westchester Manor Home 1990-1992 Manor Place and Woodlake Same floorplan similar to Magnolia 1991-1997 in Natures Place







History of Timber Pines

Development and Grand Opening of Timber Pines

In late 1978 U.S. Home submitted preliminary plans for Timber Pines in Hernando County. These plans outlined the intended use of a tree farm purchased April 18, 1981 from the Turner Corporation. Construction began immediately on the first 640 acres and our beautiful Timber Pines was born.

The Master Plan outlined the need for a commercial support area and accordingly U.S. Home sold 20 acres of the land to the Kmart Corporation which is now recognized as The Village at Timber Pines.

The remaining 620 acres were plotted. One of the first items to be constructed was the golf course. The first nine holes was named The Pines and is now the front nine of The Lakes. The second nine holes was named the Lakes and is now the back nine of The Lakes.

The Grand Opening for Timber Pines was February 7th, 1982. The models were sparkling, as were the deep green lawns, the blue sky, strains of Dixieland music, young ladies in pastel antebellum hoop skirts and brimmed hats proffering flowers.

The Lodge was under construction and the golf courses were open for play for "prospective customers." There was an abundance of food and refreshments for all. The Grand Opening was a huge success. Parking your car was a problem and finding a Sales Representative was almost as bad. Bo and Rosemary Snider made a commitment to purchase and were recognized by U.S. Home as the first couple to purchase a home in Timber Pines. They chose Lot 2 Tract 16 and closed on the home of their dreams at 2222 Westchester Boulevard in the Village of Greenbrier.

The next step was the purchase of an additional 640 acres of property on the east boundary from Dr. Gills in 1988.

The Lodge

U.S. Home submitted plans to Hernando County for a Recreational Building at Timber Pines on October 7, 1981. The building would be situated on a 7 acre plot in Track 18. This plan provided the specifications for a structure 105 feet by 195 feet and had an estimated cost of \$1, 100000. The Recreational Building was completed in less than six months and the County issued a Certificate of Occupancy on April 3, 1982. The building was then and thereafter identified as THE LODGE.

The Lodge is on a hill overlooking the fairways and greens of the golf course. The rustic Lodge is surrounded by an oversized swimming pool, tennis, courts and shuffle board courts.

This impressive structure contains 15,000 square feet devoted to the needs of all residents. The completion of the Lodge was a moor milestone in the in the success of Timber Pines. US Home celebrated with a Grand Opening of the Lodge on Sunday, April 14, 1982.

Prospective buyers were very impressed with the beauty and elegance of the Lodge. Sales for 1982 exceeded corporate expectations. One hundred ninety one units were sold during that year. Sales in the ensuing years continued to surpass projections and ultimately required major modifications to the Lodge. Space for administrative staff was the basis for the first modification. Stairs were installed and a second floor addition added to the office. The next two modifications provided more office space and an extension of the billiard room. On the southwest corner there was a golf shop where golfers would check

in before playing. The "warp around" porches on the West side were a unique feature for golfers and spectators as it allows a great view of the tees as well as the pool area.

Governance

When Timber Pines opened all the power of operation was in the hands of US Home. Eventually a number of residents were added community to the Board of Directors. However, US Home dictated how many members there would be. When 95% of the lots were sold out, U.S. Home had to kick in charges on the lots, which caused them to expedite their departure because they lost control of what would happen at Timber Pines. There was an agreement of what they would do before the formal transfer occurred on September 5, 1997 and the Timber Pine Community Association assumed management responsibility. Timber Pines is a self-governing community. There is Board of Directors supported by General supported by General Manager and his staff. There are 57 villages and each has a village rep who provides the primary communication link between the villages and the Board of Directors.

Timber Pines is self-sufficient and all reserves are funded and budgeted yearly for repair and replacement so the continuation of the lifestyle at Timber Pines is insured without the need for special assessments.

Voting in the Early Days

The early residents of Timber Pines were assigned to Precinct 23. This Precinct was located in The Weeki Wachee Senior Citizens Center that was located approximately 2 miles north and east of the Kmart Gate on Toucan Trail. The first opportunity to vote occurred September 7, 1982 for Candidates in the Hernando County primary election. During the ensuing years the rapid growth and development resulted in voters standing in long lines, usually in the hot sun, an unpleasant experience for all. The County solved this problem by assigning Precinct 35 to Timber Pines with polling moved to the Lodge in 1985.

The impact on the community has been dramatic: there were 1232 registered voters initially in Precinct 35. The steady growth of our community required the county to establish a second precinct in 1996. It was designated as Precinct 47 and The Lodge became the Polling Place for both precincts. The assignment of the second precinct caused some confusion when some residents were reassigned from precinct 35 to 47 to balance the distribution between the two. This was a temporary problem which was solved when the new Performing Arts Center was designated as the Polling Place for Precinct 47 resulting in separating the two precincts.

The Gates

When Timber Pines first opened, traffic on US 19 was reasonably light, but growing. The gate on US 19 served the prospective customers and new residents. As business growth at Kmart and Walmart was also generating increasing traffic and making turning into Timber Pines a bit of a challenge, Walmart agreed on March 2, 1992 to finance a traffic light at their entrance. The Hernando council then wrote to Robert Fertig recommending that Timber Pines build a second entrance that would align with the new Walmart light. Construction of the entrance was begun during the early part of 1993. The old construction entrance was closed and all service traffic was instructed to use the new North Gate, while the former Kmart Gate, now called the South Gate, was reserved exclusively for resident and guest use. As new home sales continued at a rapid pace and Development Plan, Phase 2, of the second 640 acres on the east side of Timber Pines was opened, the need for a third entrance became apparent. The Abilene entrance was approved by the county March 11, 1994 and construction began immediately with an official opening of the Abilene Gate occurring May 6, 1994. Attractive guard houses have graced all three entrances and the welcome look at each has been enhanced by the lovely flower plantings that are changed with the seasons to maintain a fresh colorful inviting look. To insure safety and security US Home provided for a perimeter wall resulting in a uniquely desirable gated community.

Resident Activities Center

The long awaited Resident Activities Center had its grand opening November1, 2001, with a ribbon cutting by the Board President, Bob Kennedy, who commented that The Center is the latest in a series of capital improvements intended to maintain Timber Pines reputation as premier community for active retirement.

The RAC is now a valuable addition to the resident's amenities package. The reported cost of the building and new equipment is \$996,000. This is the lion's share of the \$1.1 million budget to build the RAC and renovate the interior of the Lodge to centralize the administrative staff for greater efficiency.

The Woodworking hobby shop was moved from the Lodge and received new woodworking equipment to replace that worn out by long use at the Lodge.

The Arts & Crafts room has ample storage and special features including a locked kiln room for firing ceramics. The extra high ceilings in the room accommodates a wall of windows just below the roof line to allow natural light in the room, an advantage appreciated by the artists.

The Fitness Center has equipment from its prior site in the Country Club and supplements the broad range of new equipment that make it truly a major health workout center. A mirrored wall on one side of the room allows exercisers to view their progress and relieve the monotony of looking at a blank wall while walking a treadmill or riding a stationary bike.

The RAC offers the perfect arrangement for keeping residents minds and bodies active. Professional YMCA trainers are available to see that the equipment is properly matched to the individual users. The new Billiards Room houses eight tables that comfortably accommodate the full schedule of league players. The RAC also provides class and meeting rooms as well as spacious craft facilities.

Country Club and Performing Arts Center

The Grand Opening of the Country Club occurred February 28, 1994.

At a town meeting January 8, 1993, Director Robert Fertig reviewed the plans for the new Country Club. This building, he said, will include in the first phase a 10,500 square feet. Country Club building and in a few years a 10,000 Sq. Ft. Auditorium. The site plan called for outside amenities to include: four tennis courts, swimming pool and a golf pro shop

The Club building houses a restaurant, card room, exercise room, meeting room and a room for private parties. The restaurant is designed with a multipurpose great room that has a massive brick fireplace. There is a grill area convenient to the golf pro shop. The restaurant and grill overlook the pool and the first fairway of the Hills Golf Course. The other side of the building will be all glass and overlook the 18th green of The Pines Championship course.

Performing Arts Center

The grand opening of the Performing Arts Center was the fall of 1995.

The 10,000 Sq. Ft. Timber Pines Performing Arts Center is the "Crown Jewel" of the whole facility, said Robert Fertig, U.S. Home Corporation North Florida Division Director. The facility will seat 800. It has a full stage and dressing rooms and a flat floor rather than a traditional sloped theater floor, making the facility more functional. Seats are removable so the room can be used for large dances, parties and dinner theater. Dinners are catered from the adjacent Country Club. The facility provides an excellent stage for the Timber Pines Players Group and the Timber Tones Chorus. Resident Services book many professional entertainers that fill the broad entertainment calendar that residents are able to enjoy.

Golf at Timber Pines

The details for the "Centerpiece" of our beautiful community were started in beginning of 1979. Construction of the golf courses was one of the first projects to be programmed to insure its completion would be in phase with the master plan.

Fifty-six acres in the center of the first phase 640 acre tract were selected for the location of the two executive golf courses. Ron Garl, the noted golf course architect was hired to prepare the plans of these golf courses. He charted the lakes to enable earth moving to begin. Land development for the remaining acreage was orchestrated to maximize the greatest home site frontage with the golf courses.

Fred Tucker of U.S. Home Corporation was the first Golf Course Superintendent for Timber Pines and assisted in the construction of the courses from the inception. The St. Petersburg Times dated February 7, 1982 announcing the Grand Opening, stated, "It's been three long years in the making, but finally Timber Pines is ready for you to explore. Carved into 640 acres of rolling woodlands and lakes it highlights the wonderful golf course." Jack Welling was the first Golf Pro., assisted by his wife Ellie and their dog. They were swamped by visitors wanted to play the new courses.

Authorization to play golf was given by the U.S. Home Sales Staff as an inducement to buy. Those folks who already purchased could play by citing their lot number. Since the Lodge was under construction a temporary Pro Shop was located at the northwest corner of the Lodge.

Initially the cart paths were simply sand and generated many complaints. Next they were paved with blacktop and were initially replaced with the poured concrete that we enjoy today.

With the rapid growth of Timber Pines there was just not enough room for all the golfers on the two executive courses so the next planned phase began in 1991 with construction of the first nine holes of the Championship Grand Pines course. Then in 1993 the final nine holes were opened completing the beautiful, challenging 18 hole course.

When the final 120 acre phase was planned US Home proposed the inclusion of a 7 acre lake. However a survey of the residents indicated a desire for more golf facilities. This resulted in the nine hole Pitch and Putt course being built around the several small lakes presently in existence. It was named The Highlands Golf Course.

More Activities

Among the early sports available was the traditional game of horseshoes with two courts behind the Lodge was the place to toss the shoes. Eventually, to correct a possible dangerous activity in the busy Lodge area the courts were moved to the new Highland Golf Course area off Timber Point Blvd. In August 2005 there were the 2 courts, in 2007 they were expanded to 4 courts and in January 2011 expanded again to six courts with concrete perimeters.

Bocce is also a major activity in Timber Pines. With league players and alternates, plus casual players, over 1,000 residents are involved during the rest of the year. In the late 80s three beautiful partially covered hard surfaced Bocce courts were constructed behind the Lodge to replace the four older courts they had long served the community. The first active group was called the Pioneer club. There are now over hundred clubs and programs that have blossomed from these early days. AT the Lodge there are the craft rooms featuring ceramics with a kiln, quilting, sewing, card rooms for bridge and poker as well as Mahjongg; dance classes and exercise. Many lead to such programs as the Jazz Katts, RazzMa Taps and other major programs. The Tim Tones a 100 plus member choral group and the Timber Pines Players now

enjoy the full stage facilities at the PAC for frequent productions which are enjoyed by the residents in either theater or table seating arrangement.

Tennis and Pickle Ball

Tennis was secondary draw to Timber Pines. In the beginning there were only two tennis courts at the Lodge. When the second 640 acres were purchased and the Country Club and the PAC were designed, the plans also called for six new lighted tennis courts to be included. The interest and growth of the sport in Timber Pines has resulted in a most active organization. The Tennis Club has over 300 members and raises thousands of dollars for charities through its tournaments and social events. To support the program a major \$265,000 reconstruction of the six courts at the Country Club was completed in 2011 by converting to HarTru irrigated courts. The green pebble surface is much easier on the knees and will allow many players to extend their playing years. The evolution to tennis continues within Timber Pines as the two courts at the Lodge have now been marked out to allow Pickle 8all. A game which is now increasing in popularity among residents.

Timber Pines Animals

During the 1800's and eons prior to that, the Tocobago Indian tribe used Timber Pines as their hunting grounds. In 1982 when Timber Pines was being developed by US Home, as reported by the Pioneer group, there was an encounter with a Florida panther capturing a fawn. That created a lot of discussion among the members of the Pioneer Club. Alligators have been seen in Timber Pines since 1982. The Florida Dept. of Animals will remove the alligators if they reach 5 feet in length. Turtles of several different species are often seen. The box turtle is an endangered species and requires conservation policy to relocate to a habitat which will insure their survival. They, and the gopher tortoise were numerous in the early days of development and the sites had to be inspected before concrete could be poured so that they could safely be removed. The men assigned this task became known as the "Turtle Herders." Over 200 tortoises were relocated. The largest nesting area was in what is now Manor Place.

The Sand Hill Cranes are also a protected species and have been a constant part of the background sounds. Since the early days the honking as they fly over the villages is a reminder that they think that Timber Pines belongs to them. They also enjoy our greens. So it is not surprising that golfers must wait for them to cross the fairways.

Getting Around and Going Places

For US Home "The" bus was a busy vehicle in 1982 as it provided tours for visitors as well as transportation for shopping to area stores for the residents. The service continues to this day only the riders now enjoy BIG buses as each Thursday it makes the trip to area stores and to Gulf View Mall as well as special occasions. In other travel offerings there is the Timber Pines Global Travel Club that plan and schedule cruises, day and overnight trips as well as international trips. All guaranteed to keep Timber Pines travelers on the go.
